

# Aron Talas' Biography

Aron Talas is one of the prominent members of the Hungarian jazz scene. He has performed with Dave Liebman, Mike Moreno, Nils Petter Molvaer, Eivind Aarset, Ed Neumeister, the New York Voices, Lew Tabackin, Rossano Sportiello among others.

He worked/works with many groups in Hungary in the jazz/pop/world music scene, such as Mihály Borbély Quartet, Zoltán Lantos' Opensource, Ági Szalóki, Palya Bea, Takács Nikolas.

He was at the top ten at the Montreux Jazz Piano Competition in 2015 and was awarded several times in Hungary, such as "Junior Prima" and "Gramofon". He was voted multiple times for the "Pianist of the Year" in the main hungarian jazzsite. ([www.jazzma.hu](http://www.jazzma.hu))

With the "Aron Talas Trio" he released two albums at Gats Productions (JP) and BMC Records (HU), which earned critical acclaim.

Aron Talas teaches piano at the Béla Bartók Conservatory. He is the accompanist at Franz Liszt Academy of Music, jazz-vocals department. He visited the Jerusalem Academy of Music and Dance with the Erasmus program for teachers.

Aron Talas was also a jazz-drums/combo teacher at Kodolányi János University.
